


Pipe Connections



Complete the Finished Wall

Complete the finished wall surface.




Install the Threaded Connectors

Remove the G1/2 threaded connectors from the Showerhead. Wrap them with PTFE tape and install it onto the pipes.


Use the overhead shower as a template to mark the positions of the installation holes. Then, drill two installation holes with a 10 mm drill bit. The center distance between the holes should be approximately 140 mm.

Flush the Pipes

Turn on the main water valve and flush the pipes to prevent debris from entering and clogging the overhead shower nozzles.




Secure the Overhead Shower

Insert the metal anchors into the installation holes, then remove the nuts and washers from the anchors and set them aside.


Pass the overhead shower through the threaded connectors and anchors, then secure it with the nuts and washers that were set aside.

Use the large nuts to tighten the overhead shower to the threaded connectors, and then connect the hose to the threaded connectors.

Cleaning and care
