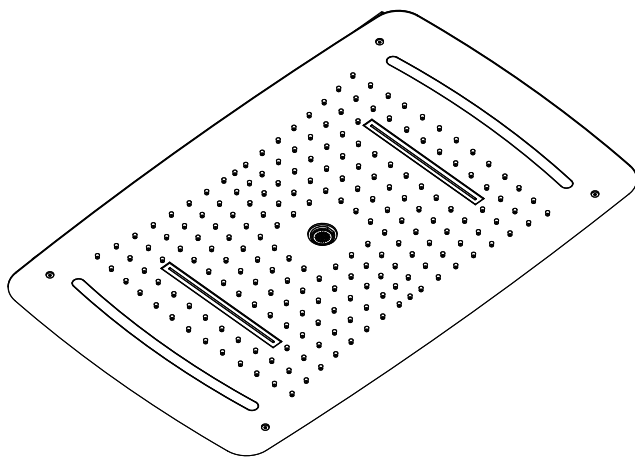

Installation Instructions

 **READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE UNPACKING THE PRODUCT** 

Important

- 1- For best results, we recommend that this unit be installed by a licensed, professional plumber.
- 2- Please read over these instructions thoroughly before beginning installation. Make sure that you have all tools and supplies needed to complete the installation.
- 3- Keep this booklet and the receipt (or other proof of date and place of purchase) for this product in a safe place. The receipt is required should it be necessary to request warranty parts.
- 4- Please keep the box and packaging materials until your product is completely installed and functional.

Caution: Always turn off the water before disassembling the valve. Open valve handle to relieve water pressure and to ensure that complete water shut-off has been accomplished.

Flushing

Important: Before closing wall openings, pressure test valve and complete system using flushing instructions.

Pipe chips, sand and other solids found in and renovated plumbing can damage the sealing surfaces of the cartridge, causing leakage or spool blockage. To avoid damage, **DO NOT TURN ON SUPPLY VALVES** until instructed.

Shower Head Installation Instructions



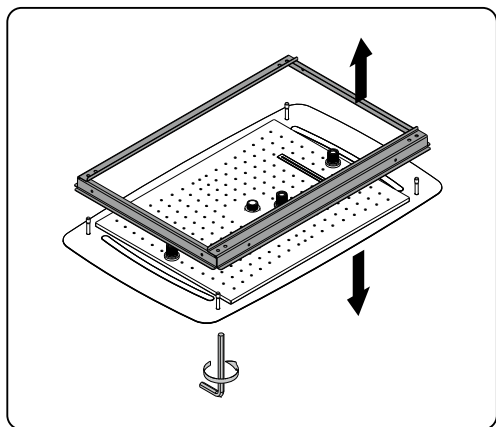
Shower Head Installation Instructions



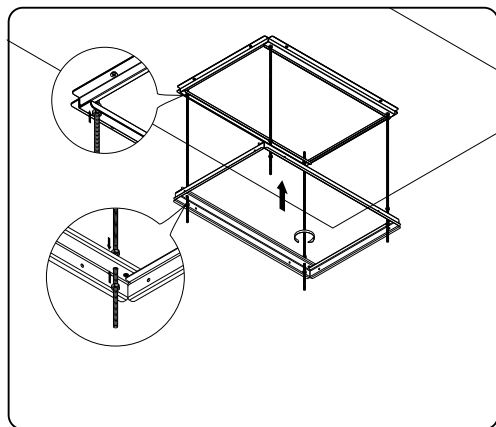
Use the upper bracket as a template to mark drill hole positions with a pencil
Drill holes at the marked locations
Insert the provided screw plugs into the drilled holes
Install the upper bracket securely in place

Please flush the pipe first to avoid the debris go inside the head shower.

This head shower need to have 3 pre-installed G1/2 water outlet.



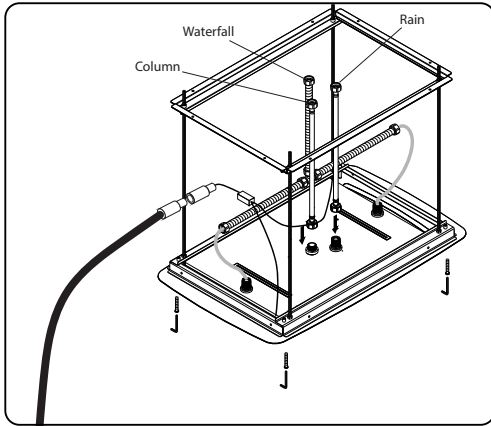
Detach the lower bracket from the showerhead using the provided Allen key.



Install the shower bracket, ensuring both brackets are level. Tighten the nuts securely with a spanner.

Trim the M6 expansion rod to fit your ceiling height if needed.

Shower Head Installation Instructions



Connect all water supply lines as shown in the diagram.

Warning: Ensure the water supply is turned OFF before connecting pipes to prevent leaks or flooding.

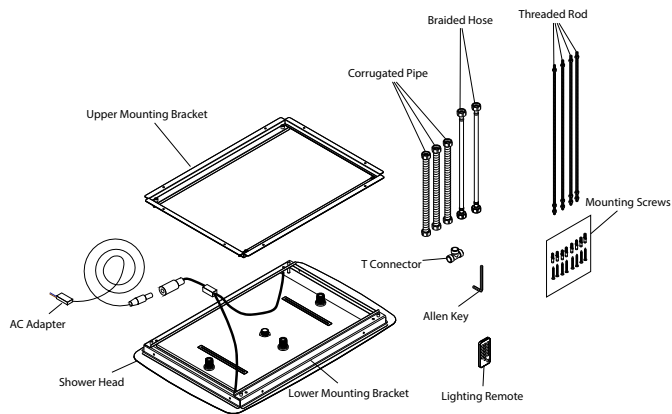
Plug the AC adapter into a grounded power outlet.

Warning: Verify that the outlet voltage matches the adapter rating (e.g., 110V/220V). Do not use damaged cords or outlets.

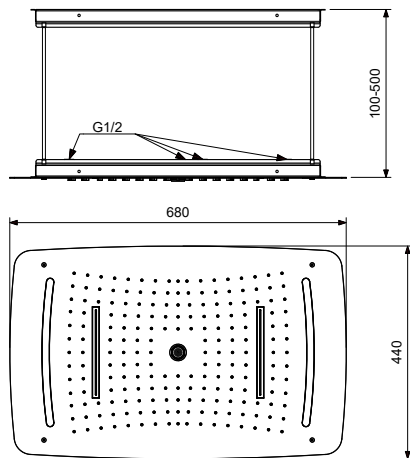
Secure the shower head unit to the bracket using the provided allen key. Tighten firmly to avoid loosening.

Confirm all connections are leak-free before turning on water.

Cleaning and care
